RALLY CRY placed in good position and tracked the pace along the outside, edged up to challenge WHEELS UP NOW at five sixteenths pole, continued to match strides into upper stretch then assumed command and drew clear. WHEELS UP NOW set the pace in the backstretch, challenged by eventual winner midway in the far turn, dueled for the lead into the lane, could not move on with rival in final furlong and kept along to finish second best. EQUINE PERFECTION raced in place position and tracked the pacesetter, moved up close between at five sixteenths pole, could not move on with top two but continued steady bid and produced solid effort for show. TOUGHEST 'OMBRE placed midpack in the backstretch, urged for response two wide entering top of lane and improved position. GRAND NENE was unhurried racing near the back, gained ground along the rail, improved position then evened out in late drive. VILMA was unhurried and raced off the pace, hustled up in the far turn, gained position but was not enough for late impact. ARCHANOVA raced near the back and passed tiring foes in the drive. HOCKEY SCHOOL raced in contention along the rail, swung out four wide in the turn and came up empty.

DERBY CHAMPAGNE failed to rally in the lane. ALL WORLD raced in the back of the field, hustled up in the far turn and failed to move into late contention. TALE OF MIST raced evenly off the pace and failed to move on when asked. BILLION STAR moved up closer at the half mile then lost position and faded back. LUCKY RAMSEY placed midpack in the backstretch, urged for response three furlongs out, could not move on and gaveway. DANGEROUS BEND dropped back after half.
