ALL WORLD raced off the pace inside, between foes on the far turn, rallied outside and wore down WAR ORDER in deep stretch. WAR ORDER was bumped at the start, vied three wide, took over on the turn, drew clear and yielded late. WARRIOR CALL raced off the rail, three wide on the far turn and dug in to earn the show. SOUPER TRUE was bumped at the start, raced close up inside, between foes at the quarter pole and finished evenly on the rail. THORNADO vied inside and weakened. HARD LABOR raced off the rail, three wide on the far turn and had no rally. TE ENCUESTRO vied two wide and faded. HOW SO raced three wide early and gave way.
