THREE YEAR OLDS WHICH HAVE NEVER WON A SWEEPSTAKES. Free nomination by Friday, April 14. \$750 to enter and start. \$75,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of three races other than maiden, claiming, or starter allowed 2 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at the time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. If more than 14 horses are entered, preference will be given by highest career earnings.

CLASSIC ROCK came under slight restraint in opening stages while matching strides placed three deep, edged away in hand three furlongs out, came under a ride, drew off to confident lead then finished in hand. CHATIMENT was allowed to settle off early speed then angled inside near half mile marker, roused five wide for the drive and gained runner up spot. KATALOX was well positioned placed off top trio, hustled up past three eighths pole, continued to chase after CLASSIC ROCK in the lane but was no match for clear winner, flattened and secured show. COLEMAN ROCKY raced between rivals in backstretch, kept between in the turn, roused three to four wide in lane and needed more to make late impact. CROCODILE CHARLIE lacked speed racing near the back, moved to outside top stretch and had mild improve. FIELD TRIP pulled in opening stages and vied for lead racing between, could not move on with eventual winner but kept on then had no kick left in lane. GENERAL OBVIOUS steadily lost ground and finished wide in lane. ALUM was restless at break and came away in back, lacked speed and failed to move into range. CORONADO AGAIN vied for early lead then retreated after the half.
