ALUM pressed then vied for the lead racing along the outside of GEMOLOGISTER, roused for more at head of the lane, shook free from rival approaching the furlong marker then pulled away under steady urging. QUALITY ASSET drifted out and bumped with rival at the start, tracked the top two leaders in the backstretch, produced bid along outside entering the lane, could not catch eventual winner but finished clearly second best. GEMOLOGISTER raced on top under pressure from ALUM, duelled for the lead with aforementioned rival upper stretch, could not move on with eventual winner approaching the furlong marker then weakened. ONE PROUD WILDCAT was unhurried in the backstretch, picked up the pace then roused along outside, improved position. GOLDEN DIAMOND settled in off early pace while saving ground, roused along outside in the turn, came under left handed urging, moved closer inside and lacked needed rally for impact. SUMMER CAUSEWAY trailed in the back of the field, hustled up along outside in the turn, came under right handed urging and angled closer inside, failed to make impact. VIVE LE ROI was bumped at the start then raced near midpack, could not sustain bid, faded. ANDRES MAXIMUS raced in contention then dropped back and was distanced in the lane.
