BETTING went up inside to the early lead, set a pressured pace, inched away leaving the backstretch then battled inside into the turn, kicked away again on the turn, came off the rail into the stretch and drew clear under urging. AMERICAN LEAGUE came in then was forced in more at the break, chased five wide then three deep, continued outside leaving the turn and into the stretch and just held second. CLASSICO steadied when bumped and squeezed at the start, settled off the rail then outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and just missed the place. BLANKET OF ICE chased between horses then a bit off the rail, split rivals again on the turn and lacked the needed rally. SORRYABOUTNOTHING was squeezed and steadied between foes at the break, stalked between horses then three deep between foes on the turn and into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. SWISS MINISTER came in onto foes at the start, angled in and prompted the pace inside then stalked off the rail leaving the backstretch, bid again outside the winner into the turn, tracked that one off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. JES JAA broke in and a bit slowly, pulled early, stalked inside and also weakened in the drive. ADMIRAL BOOM bumped just after the start, chased between foes then three deep, continued off the rail on the turn, angled in some leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
