MINER'S LIGHT settled a bit off the rail, came out and moved up four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch to gain the lead, inched clear past midstretch and was caught on the wire. ON FIRE prompted the pace three deep on the backstretch and again on the turn, took a short lead between foes a quarter mile out, fought back into the stretch and held third. DRESSED IN HERMES settled outside, advanced four wide leaving the turn and between horses into the stretch to bid for the lead and was edged for the show. AMERICAN LEAGUE chased a bit off the rail, split rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. PATH OF DAVID hopped a bit at the start, chased inside on the backstretch and turn and lacked a response in the stretch. ED JOHNSON had speed four wide then stalked three deep, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. TIZ A BILLY angled in and dueled between horses on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. NUKE LALOOSH sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, fought back on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
