## Footnotes

AMERICAN LEAGUE three deep early, stalked outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, inched away and held gamely under urging. BEAUMARCHAIS had speed between horses then dueled inside, fought back leaving the second turn and continued willingly along the rail in the stretch. JUNIOR GILLIAM saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and got up for the show. IMPERIOUS ONE (IRE) bobbled a bit at the start, angled in and dueled outside a rival then between horses leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was edged late for third. DR. GO stalked the pace three wide to the stretch and lacked a rally. START A RUNNIN sent inside early, saved ground stalking the pace, came out for room into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. TRUST YOUR GUT stalked the pace between horses to the stretch and weakened. BLANKET OF ICE broke slowly and was squeezed some, angled in and saved ground off the pace, cut the corner into the stretch and failed to menace. DREAMY MARTINI between horses early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
