Footnotes

FABOZZI bobbed at the start, stalked three deep then bid outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, took the lead in upper stretch, kicked clear and held under left handed urging. CHAMPAGNE CHARLEY (FR) pulled some and chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and finished well. TRIBAL FIGHTER pulled and steadied between horses into the first turn, stalked between foes then a bit off the rail into the stretch and held third. TOP OF THE GAME angled in and was unhurried toward the inside then along the rail, came out a bit leaving the backstretch, swung three deep into the stretch and just missed the show. DYNAMIC SCORING steadied in tight into the first turn, stalked inside, split rivals on the second turn, came out some into the stretch and was outfinished. G. A. BETTING had speed outside then dueled alongside a rival, battled inside the winner but a bit off the rail on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. STUDENT BODY LEFT broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, angled back in and lacked the needed rally. LITTLE SCOTTY steadied in tight between horses into the first turn, stalked between rivals, came out four wide into the stretch and weakened. AMERICAN LEAGUE pulled between horses and steadied off heels approaching the first turn, stalked between rivals then outside a foe, went between horses again on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. CHRIS AND DAVE stalked four wide, advanced four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, then also weakened. BEAUMARCHAIS broke a bit slowly, settled three deep then chased outside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. SENSE OF GLORY between horses early, dueled inside then stalked along the rail, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
