Footnotes

HE'S VERY RARE had speed off the rail then dueled outside a rival, battled between horses leaving the turn, drifted out a bit into the stretch, fought back between foes through the final furlong and gamely prevailed under urging. DROVER CRAZY stalked just off the rail, split horses in upper stretch, bid along the rail and continued willingly to the wire. BASMATI stalked outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid four wide to gain the advantage in upper stretch, fought back three wide through the final furlong and was outgamed. DEAD EASY broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and found his best stride late. AMERICAN LEAGUE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. HORSE LAUGH chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and also weakened. WHAT WE DOING chased just off the rail then inside into and on the turn, came off the fence in the stretch and had little left for the drive.
