TURULU had good early speed then stalked off the rail, split rivals on the turn, came out in the stretch, rallied under urging to the lead a sixteenth out and won clear. DALMORE prompted the pace three deep then outside a rival on the turn, took the lead into the stretch, inched away and lugged inward despite left handed urging in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. AMERICAN LEAGUE stalked the pace outside then three deep to the stretch and continued willingly to best the others. GO LONG sped to the early lead, dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch, steadied behind the runner-up in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. MR. GAME SEVEN saved ground stalking the pace, came out leaving the turn and around a rival into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. GUNFIRE broke in and bumped a rival, settled off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. CRUSHIN CANDY bumped at the start, was sent between horses to duel for the lead, dropped back on the turn and gave way.
