Footnotes

TAPWRIT raced between rivals off the top two leaders in the backstretch, moved up to challenge COMMANDEERING at the quarter pole, dueled along the outside, edged away at sixteenth pole and finished in hand at the wire. COMMANDEERING vied for the early lead racing along the outside of STUN, moved away from rival and quickly took on the challenge of GOLDEN DIAMOND, fought off rival in far turn, never got a break and took on challenge of TAPWIT, dueled along the inside, fought back gamely after being pressured throughout but lacked needed kick in reserve to move on late, finished clearly ahead of rest. MISTER HAYES was rated along the rail in the backstretch, lost position, dropped back but continued steady bid and moved by tiring rivals to regain position. GOLDEN DIAMOND bobbed at the start then came out four to five wide entering first turn, stalked the pace in the backstretch, moved up to challenge COMMANDEERING at three eighths pole, could not move on with rival but continued up close entering the lane, could not keep up pace, faded. STUN vied for the early lead racing along the inside of COMMANDEERING, could not move on with rival leaving the backstretch and steadily faded. GASPROM raced near the back and failed to move into contention. AMERICAN TZAR trailed the field, eased up in the lane and walked off after the race.
