
KEENELAND - April 8, 2017 - Race 10

STAKES Toyota Blue Grass S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred



123 lbs. Certain finishing positions in this race will earn points to qualify for the 2017 Kentucky Derby, pursuant to the official rules for the Kentucky Derby published by Churchill Downs Incorporated. The maximum number of starters for the Toyota Blue Grass will be limited to fourteen. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference given to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner.

IRAP tracked the pace early along the four path, shifted into the three path in the far turn, took over command, drew clear in the stretch, dug in and held gamely in the final stages. PRACTICAL JOKE chased the pace early from the four path, swung into the six path entering the lane, made a bid in the stretch but did not have enough in the final stages. MCCRAKEN broke out at the start, stalked the pace early along the three path, was between horses throughout the backstretch, got out in the far turn, fanned into the seven path entering the lane, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. J BOYS ECHO bobbled and was bumped at the start, raced back early from the three path, was bumped around between horses entering the far turn, fanned into the seven path entering the lane and moved up in the stretch run. TAPWRIT was unprepared at the start and raced back early on from the three path, fanned into the eight path in the far turn and improved position down the lane. IT'S YOUR NICKEL was well placed early while off the rail, shifted into the three path in the far turn and was empty late in the stretch drive. WILD SHOT set the pace early while off the rail, stayed off the rail entering the lane and gave way down the lane.
