AMETRINE sat reserved in the two path for the opening half, swung four wide into the stretch, kicked into her best stride coming to the eighth pole, overhauled the fighting front ruinners near the wire to wrest away the decision. SAME KINDA CRAZY sat perched three wide, picked up interest as the half was being completed, got set down for the drive after spinning into the stretch, closed in on the one to catch to hitch up with slighter under a furlong to go, fought her way to a slim lead during the final stages, had it turn to be a short-lived one though, having no answer once the winner arrived on the scene. TRUE CHARM gained the advantage soon after the start, cut over to the inside, set the opening split while being engaged by GALWAY GIRL, confidently ridden by the pilot throughout it all, gradually edged away from the competition during the run around the bend, settled into upper stretch and was switched over a drive, had the runner up drew up and ignite a second duel for this gal, battled well into the seventy yards before permanently releasing the lead and weakening into the show slot. BEA BEA tucked along the rail and lacked the necessary stretch response. TIFFANYS FREUD unhurried while two wide for the first half, was sent out into path five from upper to midstretch, made no impact. KATIE ICE rated along, rode the rail, was cued up getting angled out to avoid a retreating foe, that being GALWAY GIRL, as the half was being completed, shiftted slighter wider after settling in, lugged in past the furlong marker, was corrected, then finished fairly evenly. TOWN FAIR sneaked its way onto the inside route nearing the end of the backstrech, was called upon angling into the two path heading for the top of the lane, failed to fire appreciably. GALWAY GIRL keen early, sparred for command from the two path, got shaken off after entering the turn, had little left by the end of the bend, faded down the lane.
