KUNDRAY tracked the front runners while coaxed along in the pocket, slipped off the inside route after completing six furlongs, remained on hold bidding time during the remainder of the journey to the end of the second bend, was called upon for run spinning three wide into the stretch, gained ground readily, enough so to begin the final furlong with only a slim deficit left to be made up, took over in short order and drew clear, kept to encouragement to the end. OUT OF NOWHERE narrowly out-broke the competition and maintained the advantage, got guided over to the rail, carved out the pace, being rated and with PREYING MANTIS close enough in the two path to apply pressure, had that opponent issue a strong challenge as three-quarters was being reached, answered it by being put to a drive a few jumps later, rebuffed the bid but gained no respite, what with the eventual winner bearing down hard by the end of the furlong grounds, yielded leaving the eighth pole, but continued onward in a willing manner to garner the place. BEA BEA saved ground for most of the way to the end of the backstretch, got eased into path two after stepping onto the far turn, remained on hold, got roused up coming three wide into the stretch, altered course back into the two path almost right afterwards, then mustered up a mild response sufficient enough to claim the show award. PREYING MANTIS was rated in the two path attending the pacesetter, drew up to that foe to initiate a challenge approaching the five-sixteenths marker, got called upon soon afterwards, vied with vigor until deep into the furlong grounds, wasn't able to take over then backed away. WAKE UP SMILING off a half length slower than other, was pulling on the bit in the shadow of the starting gate, rushed up into a forward position travelling three wide on the first turn, remained prominently spotted three wide on the turn two as well, entered the stretch and gave way. TATTLETALE GREY was checked getting taking back on the clubhouse turn, tucked along the rail for the run around the second one, was never involved.
