LONG HOT SUMMER stalked outside a rival or off the rail, bid between horses into the stretch to gain the lead, inched away in midstretch and won clear under left handed urging and steady handling late. GRAND YODELER chased a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch and edged rivals for third while between foes late. L. A. MAGIC dueled outside a rival then inched away and angled in leaving the hill, fought back along the rail into the stretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong and was edged for the place. STEALTH DRONE fractious in the gate, dueled off the rail then stalked inside down the hill and into the stretch and was edged for third. BELLE ET BETE (IRE) chased off the rail then inside, went outside a rival leaving the hill, bid three wide into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. EVO CAMPO (IRE) broke in and slowly to be away behind the field, settled inside, came out some in the stretch and was not a threat. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
