Footnotes

SHE'S A BIG WINNER dueled outside a rival, inched away into the stretch, battled alongside the runner-up through the final furlong, drifted in slightly but held on gamely then edged away under some late urging nearing the wire. BOBBI GRACE (IRE) a bit slow to begin, chased inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, was in a bit tight a sixteenth out, fought back but could not quite match the winner late. SPIRIT OF XIAN (IRE) chased between horses then a bit off the rail leaving the hill, steadied off heels nearing the dirt crossing, moved up inside in the stretch then came out a bit late and finished willingly. MIO ME stalked three deep then four wide leaving the hill, came five wide into the stretch and was outfinished. MINKS APRISE away a bit slowly, stalked just off the rail then between horses leaving the hill and into the stretch, came out some past midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. HAVANNA BELLE (IRE) hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, saved ground off the pace and improved position inside in the stretch. MORNING COFFEE stalked three deep then four wide leaving the hill and into the stretch, steadied briefly past the sixteenth pole and could not offer the necessary response. SHH SHE'S OURS had speed off the rail then angled in and dueled inside, fought back leaving the hill, came a bit off the fence in the stretch and weakened. WEDDING BLUSH chased between horses then dropped back leaving the hill and into the stretch and did not rally. BELLE ET BETE (IRE) stalked the pace between horses then three deep leaving the hill and into the stretch and weakened. SISTER OF MERCY (IRE) settled outside then three deep on the hill and into the stretch and lacked a response in the stretch. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed

by the stewards, who ruled though there were tight quarters in the drive the incident did not alter the original order of finish. Rail on hill at zero.
