DANETTE chased the front four then three wide through the turn advancing into close aim placed to coaxing with five-sixteenths to go, angled four wide for home and took over command straightened away, inched away to the eighth pole coming under threat from REGIA MARIA inside that station dug in under a drive and held sway rebuffing that rival to the wire. REGIA MARINA inside just behind the leader in pursuit, angled sharply five wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied to issue a challenge through the final furlong but was ultimately repelled through to the line while well clear of the rest and second best. FAST RETAILING saved ground at the rear, came under encouragement three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, passed tired foes for the show honors. MOONLIT BAY chased the pace three wide in range of the front, got let out nearing the quarter pole and swung three wide at that station between foes, weakened in the final eighth. RIGHT DECISION stumbled at the start getting away last, recovered to settle just off the pace two to three wide, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, angled four wide into upper stretch and tired. BLAME DIXIE away well, showed the way along the inside in hand, got asked as the pressure began to increase nearing the quarter pole and swung just off the inside at the station into upper stretch under threat from a pair, got headed straightened away and tired.
