STAKES Soaring Softly S. Black Type - Thoroughbred

FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight 122 lbs.

Non-winners of \$60,000 on the turf allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 or two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowed 4 lbs.; of a race other than maiden, claiming, starter or state bred allowed 6 lbs. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, May 7, 2016 with 19 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at SSeven Furlongs on the main track.) (Rail at 9 feet).

**Footnotes**

LIGHTSTREAM broke about two lengths slower than any other, after losing her footing springing from the gate, was towards the inside for a good ways down the backstretch before moving into the two path in time for commencement of the run around the bend, sat reserved, swung into actoin spinning four wide into the stretch, kicked into her best stride after being straightened away, arrived at the eighth pole with a strong showing of momentum, took charge past the sixteenth marker and edged away from a resolute opponent. SUMMER READING settled into the three path after the start, disputed the pace as the widest of a trio on the turn, spun into the lane holding the lead by a long neck or so, still in hand and with each of the other pace combatants being asked for run, settled in before switched over to a drive, began the last eighth in possession of her largest advantage, dug in with good determination before reluctantly releasing the lead with well under a sixteenth to go. WELCOMING well rated along the rail to the quarter pole, angled five wide into the stretch, finished with good energy down the outside of the strip to secure the show. SAHARAN pocketed behind the three-way pace dispute, angled into the two path at the head of the stretch, altered course back to the rail in midstretch, flattened out. SEASIDE SCHILLER momentarily wedged in the three path at the half mile pole, took up the chase a bit closer to the rail afterwards, failed to menace. WONDERMENT put to a stout hold after the break, was forced to defend a narrow lead matched up against a pair of opponents parked out two and three wide respectively, was the first to have its rider commit to a drive, doing so coming to the quarter pole, vied for command a little longer then faltered. BRINKLEY broke slightly inward, was in the two path disputing the pace from the middle of rivals from the top of the bend to midlane, gave way.
