FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs.

Non-winners of \$90,000 in 2015-16 allowed 2 lbs.; of \$60,000 in 2016 allowed 4 lbs.; of two races other than maiden, claiming, starter or state-bred allowance races in 2016 allowed 6 lbs.; of such a race in 2016 allowed 8 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. The New York Racing Association reserves the right to transfer this race to the main track. Closed Saturday, July 16, 2016 with 24 Nominations. (If the Stewards consider it inadvisable to run this race on the turf course, this race will be run at Five and One Half Furlongs on the main track.)

LOST RAVEN was hustled from the gate, brushed with QUICK RELEASE early, set the pace off the rail while under pressure from the outside, vied in the two path on the turn, was roused outside the quarter-pole, dueled with the runner-up under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip at the eighth-pole, continued a spirited battle while drifting out and gamely won the head-bob. QUICK RELEASE was asked from the gate, brushed with LOST RAVEN early, pressed the pace on the outside of that foe, vied in the three path on the turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, drew even with the leader at the quarter-pole, dueled outside under a right-handed whip in the stretch, was carried out late and lost the head-bob in a gallant effort. BRINKLEY broke out then was corrected with a tug of the left rein, chased the pace on the outside then in the four path on the turn, was put to a right-handed whip inside the five-sixteenths, switched to a left-handed whip in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong then went back to a right-handed whip and weakened. J LA TACHE broke out and hit the gate, was urged in the very early going then taken in hand, tossed her head while being wrestled back by the rider inside the five-eighths then dropped in, drafted in the two path early on the turn, was given her cue at the five-sixteenths, chased three wide into the stretch, was put to a right-handed whip before the three-sixteenths and tired.
