**Footnotes**

OUTSIDER ART showed early speed on the outside then settled off the pace, dropped in near the half-mile pole, was well placed along the rail on the turn, came off the inside outside the quarter-pole, made a three wide bid into the stretch, bumped with BRINKLEY near the three-sixteenths, battled with that rival under a hand ride, shook clear into the final sixteenth and proved best under moderate hand urging. ORZO hit the gate at the start and was off a half-step slow, settled at the rear of the field, went two then three wide on the turn, was taken up while green behind horses coming to the quarter-pole, shifted five wide into the stretch, gained momentum while on the far outside, was put to a right-handed whip at the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and finished with late energy to garner the place. BRINKLEY broke a bit slow, moved out while urged along off the pace, was taken in hand outside the seven-sixteenths pole, dropped back while lugging out some into the turn, was put to a drive while four to five wide on that bend, advanced quickly on the outside coming to the quarter-pole, made a bid at the three-sixteenths then bumped with OUTSIDER ART, battled with that rival while outside until near the sixteenth-pole then weakened and was caught for the place. FIRED UP SENSATION broke about a length and a half slow, settled towards the back while on the outside, dropped in a bit at the half-mile pole, went around most of the turn in the three path, angled five wide outside the quarter-pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip inside the furlong marker, dropped in at the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick. GEM showed speed on the outside then stalked the pace, came under coaxing while two then three wide on the turn, was taken up between horses while four wide outside the quarter-pole, turned into the stretch then was put to a drive and lacked the needed response. SCATOOSH was hustled from the start, contested the pace on the inside in hand, was let out while along the rail on the turn, inched clear at the five-sixteenths, lost the advantage while put to a drive in upper stretch, dropped back under the whip and gave way. MISS PAC N SHIP (GB) dropped back while urged along, saved ground on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch and failed to rally. CITY SIREN disputed the pace between horses then outside passing the half-mile pole, vied two to three wide on the turn, dropped back at the five-sixteenths and stopped. (Rail at 27 Feet)
