CAPRIANA tracked the pace along the inside just off the pace, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung just off the inside into upper stretch splitting the former top pair, assumed command straightened away as the leader backed away and edged clear under a drive kept to task. ACK NAUGHTY just off the inside near the rear, tucked to the fence into the far turn advancing to the inside of SUGAR MAGS, bobbled just past the five-sixteenths, cornered just off the inside for home following the aforementioned foe into upper stretch, ran on to chase that rival home unable to reel her in and was along for the place honors well clear of the rest and second best. SATURDAY BLISS sputtered in hand three then two wide through the first turn in tandem with FIRST CHARMER to her inside, settled attending that rival down the backstretch and had the rest of the field advance into striking range nearing the far turn, came under light coaxing nearing the five-sixteenths, swung three wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, proved no match for the top pair while keeping on to just hold a head decision over SUGAR MAGS for the show honors. SUGAR MAGS saved ground in mid pack in hand until put to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, improved position never threatening the top pair while along for the last major share. CONQUEST SUPERSTEP two to three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under urging five-sixteenths from home, angled five wide for home, weakened

in the stretch. LOON RIVER three wide through the first turn, chased four wide under coaxing from the three-eighths, continued four wide for home and tired. LANGFIRST coaxed from the gate, chased three wide between foes coming under a ride three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch and tired. SINGSONG saved ground at the rear, got pushed along three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, offered no response. ROCKIN ALLI forwardly placed two to three wide, got coaxed along five-sixteenths from home, swung four wide at the quarter pole and tired. FIRST CHARMER spurted in tandem inside of SATURDAY BLISS through the opening bend before settling in hand inside under attendance from the rival to the outside, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, cut the corner into upper stretch under threat, succumbed the front straightened away for home and faltered.
