NECK OF THE MOON was taken in hand, raced in the two path early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, was rated just off the pace, drafted inside early on the far turn, came off the rail late on that bend, was asked while shifting three wide into the stretch, moved out a path after straightening for the drive, made an outside bid at the three-sixteenths, battled with the runner-up in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under a strong hand ride. CAPRIANA went three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the quarter-pole, had the measure of two rivals to his inside in upper stretch but was joined on the outside by the winner, came under a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, switched to her left lead outside the sixteenth-pole, was switched to a left-handed whip after doing so, battled with the winner to the wire and just missed. SWEAR BY IT was bumped at the start by PORVOO and forced into making light contact with MAURA'S PASS then in tight, raced inside on the first turn, was undurried at the back, came under urging while in the two path on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip upper stretch, battled into the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while in the two path on the far turn, scale and finished with good energy near the center of the course to garner the show. RUN TO MAMA raced in the two path on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while in the two path on the far turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, battled into the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, made a bid while in the two path on the far turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, battled into the final

furlong then weakened. DEVIOUS MADDY broke out at the start, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved near the back, came under urging in the two path on the far turn, moved out some while under a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. MAURA'S PASS became very rank and tossed her head while off heels in the two path on the first turn, continued very rank under a strangle hold until almost the five-eighths pole, moved up when let out a bit at that point, was gathered back up some before the half-mile pole, raced in the two path while asked early on the far turn, moved to the three path late on that bend, came four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. LUCKY NANCY E. was a bit eager while three wide on the first turn, raced on the outside while under some restraint, was asked while three to four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. GRACEFUL GAL broke out some at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. AMBER MORNING went to the front, set the pace on the inside through tepid fractions, was asked inside the five-sixteenths, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. PORVOO broke through the gate prior to the start, came out at the start then bumped with SWEAR BY IT, was taken up off heels while inside midway through the first turn, raced under stout restraint, came up on heels again near the five-eighths pole, saved ground early on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch and faltered.
