WYETH just off the pace tracking along the inside, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, tipped to the two path a furlong from home, rallied to latch on the leader a sixteenth out, tussled with that foe to the wire and just got up in the last bob. JESS I AM established the front and showed the way along the inside in hand until put to coaxing five-sixteenths from home, cut the corner into upper stretch, edged away to the eighth pole, dug in stubbornly under growing threat through the final sixteenth, got nailed on the wire losing the bob and was forced to settle for the place honors. CARIBBEAN chased two to three wide from mid pack coming under coaxing midway on the far turn, swung three wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the show honors. NINETY ONE ASSAULT just off the inside in closest range of the leader, came under encouragement five-sixteenths out, continued just off the inside into upper stretch, kept on through the drive and was outfinished in the late going. SOMESVILLE three to four wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under urging at the three-eighths, swung four wide for home, made no late headway. LOUIES BABY BOY two to three wide in purusit, got coaxed along with three furlongs to run, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered no response. NEVER SO FEW (IRE) saved ground near the rear, got ridden along midway on the far turn, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, offered no response. KITTEN'S DILEMMA chased just off the inside at the rear a bit greenly growing detached from the main body of the field, swung three to four wide for home and trailed.
