Footnotes

CARIBBEAN was asked leaving the gate then driven between between horses into the first turn, went three wide on that bend, stalked the pace on the outside, turned up the pressure on the leader while in the three path on the far turn, was asked while being carried four wide into the stretch, brushed with PROUD ZIP while moving to the front outside the three-sixteenths, came under a right-handed whip while continuing to battle with the aforementioned rival at the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed whip just after edging clear at the sixteenth-pole and proved best under good handling. PROUD ZIP broke very fast and went straight to the front, went around the first turn in the two path, set the pace through moderate fractions while off the inside, came under increased pressure in the two path on the far turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths, floated three wide into the stretch under a left-handed whip, brushed with CARRIBEAN outside the three-sixteenths, fought with that rival into the final furlong, switched to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter and was outfinished while well clear for the place. CONQUEST STREETWAR was taken in hand early, dropped to the rail early on the first turn, settled just behind the leader, inched forward under some urging outside the five-eighths pole, moved within a half-length of the leader, dropped back while put to stronger urging at the half-mile pole, chased inside early on the far turn, dropped back at the five-sixteenths and capitulated. ARCH CONTENDER stood in the gate at the start, swerved out leaving the stall and spotted the rest of the field about three lengths, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along while inside early on the second turn, came off the rail late on that bend, swung four wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. IMMUNITY went four wide early on the first turn then tucked into the three path, settled on the outside, was coaxed along passing the five-eighths pole, raced three then four wide on the far turn, was asked at the three-eighths, passed the five-sixteenths under a right-handed whip, floated five wide into the stretch then drifted out, switched to a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths and had nothing left. JOYWAVE was caught five wide early on the first turn then moved to the two path, dropped back under urging on the backstretch, was ridden along while two then three wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor.
