SCISSORS AND TAPE opened clear to dictate terms and remained unchallenged. CARIBBEAN settled in hand, came four wide, finished willingly to clearly prove second best. MR. SENSIBILITY was unhurried into stride, finished with some late run and was along for the show. JAZZ MAN was forwardly placed between horses through the second turn and tired. COSMIC QUEST broke slow, lagged well back, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. DOUGLASCROWFEATHER failed to respond. ECLAT contended along the inside for six furlongs and retreated. WAGON BOSS settled between horses, drifted out leaving the second turn and stopped.
