PEE WEE REESE sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fought back under urging when headed in the stretch, regained the advantage a sixteenth out and inched away late. KENJISSTORM bobbled slightly at the start, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went three deep into the second turn, bid outside the winner, took a short lead into the stretch and was outgamed in the final furlong. CHAMPAGNE CHARLEY (FR) a bit slow into stride, angled in and settled inside, split horses leaving the second turn, found the inside again in the stretch and edged a rival for the show. STRINGENT chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and was edged for third three deep on the line. WAR ENVOY stalked a bit off the rail or outside a rival, continued just off the fence on the second turn and was edged for a minor award between foes late. ROYAL ALBERT HALL (GB) chased outside a rival then inside on the second turn, steadied in tight off heels nearing the quarter pole, came out for room into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ALFA BIRD pressed the pace outside the winner, was between horses into the second turn, fell back and angled in leaving that turn and weakened.
