FELDINI stalked off the rail then bid outside a rival early on the backstretch and again into the second turn, took a short lead leaving that turn, fought back just off the inside in the final furlong and held gamely under urging. CHRIS AND DAVE had speed three deep then angled in and stalked inside, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, bid outside the winner in the drive and continued willingly but could not quite match that one late. TOP OF THE GAME angled in and stalked inside, came out into the stretch and finished with interest. G. A. BETTING sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, turned back the winner early on the backstretch and edged away again, dueled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CHEWY ROUND TOWN (IRE) angled in and chased outside a rival then between horses on the second turn and a bit off the rail into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. UNDENIABLE U angled in and settled inside then came out into the backstretch, moved up three deep approaching the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response in the drive. CHAMPAGNE CHARLEY (FR) a step slow to begin, chased outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in upper stretch and did not rally. MISHEGAS angled in and saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and also lacked a rally.
