PROFESSOR BERNS angled in and settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went outside a foe on the backstretch, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up nearing the wire. TEMPLE KEYS chased outside a rival, split horses in midstretch and rallied between foes in deep stretch to just miss. MISSION DRIVEN squeezed slightly at the start, angled in and settled a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn, came out nearing midstretch, bid between foes in deep stretch and continued willingly. RYE PATCH had good early speed and set a pressured pace

inside, inched away leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, kicked clear and held on well to late stretch but was overtaken nearing the wire. DYNAMIC SCORING angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch, bid between foes in deep stretch and was outfinished. CHAMPAGNE CHARLEY (FR) saved ground stalking the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and could not quite summon the needed late kick. BUYMEABOND stumbled at the start, angled in and chased inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and also lacked the necessary late response. CARDIAC angled in and pressed the pace outside a rival, stalked alongside a foe on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. BUSTER DOUGLAS (BRZ) squeezed a bit at the start, pulled and stalked between horses, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and also weakened. DARK ENERGY bobbled at the start, stalked three deep, dropped back on the second turn and into the stretch and had little left for the drive. SIR SEARSUCKER was away a bit awkwardly, settled just off the rail, was pulled up on the backstretch but walked off.
