

COMFORT took up postion in the pocket after appearing to get away to a clean start, was hand urged for a good portion of the time keepiing watch on the front runners, was put a firmer hold lacking suitable options during the last few jumps leading up to the quarter pole, gained usable passage along the inside corridor soon after stepping into the lane and after being given his cue eagerly availed of the opportunity, loomed boldly at the eighth pole, as did several others to the outside, was the one, however, to gain the lead in short order and drew clear. MILLS raced sluggishly during the initial stages, departed the backstretch from the three path, was put to a drive coming to the five-sixteenths marker, fanned wider and wider for optimal clearance, wound up in the six path before attaining, rallied with good energy down the center of the strip to garner the place. THREE ALARM FIRE established control soon after the start, cut over to the inside, carved out the pace on a loosely-contested lead while pulling a bit on the bit down the backstretch, came under heavy pressure as six furlongs was being reached, got put to a drive entering the stretch, drifted out towards the outside right around the three-sixteenths pole, would continue to drift out slightly at moments thereafter, gave in to the onslaught past the furlong marker and weakened into the show slot. OUR CARAVAN settled into three path after the break, ranged up to increase its presence and issue a challenge as six furlongs was being reached, kept up the bid but only now being four wide from upper to midstretch then backed away. HEREDITARY stalked the pace from the two path, sat reserved behind a wall of foes beginning from past the five-sixteenths pole, was given his cue angling three wide into the stretch, had the rider take hold for a jump at intervals when its path was temporarily squeezed down in size while proceeding the stretch. FARHAAN travelled three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch, took a run at the front runners during the en
