Footnotes

KING OF NEW YORK was allowed to settle, ranged into striking distance on the second turn, angled out five wide entering the stretch, kicked on and reeled in CAPITAL LETTERS in the final yards. COWBOY RHYTHM attended the pace along the inside, shifted out looking for room entering the stretch and bumped WHATEVERYBODYWANTS near the three-sixteenths pole, tacked back to the inside and got through when CAPITAL LETTERS drifted out a bit, continued on willingly but was unable to reach the winner. CAPITAL LETTERS opened clear and angled in to set the pace, drifted out a bit during the drive, but weakened slightly between runners and settled for the show. WHATEVERYBODYWANTS came away a step slow, ranged into contention three wide, bid between horses on the second turn, was bumped and caught in tight entering the stretch and wilted in the drive. JESSICA'S STAR was close up three wide, faltered between horses entering the stretch, drifted about bumping ABRAHAM near the furlong marker as she retreated. ABRAHAM contended four wide, flattened entering the stretch, was bumped and fanned out deeper near the eighth pole and came up empty thereafter. GEOTHERMAL trailed.
