## Footnotes

GOLDEN GLINT prompted the pace two wide, gained a short lead mid way on the far turn and drove clear late. REFLECTING hugged the rail the far turn, eased out to the two path turning for home, stumbled and bumped with SAINT PIERRE when clipping the heels of GOLDEN GLINT inside the eighth pole then closed gamely late between horses. SAINT PIERRE circled the far turn three deep, reached a striking position in mid stretch then hung after bumping with REFLECTING inside the eighth pole. CRAFTSMAN (IRE), steadied in close quarters approaching the first turn, raced four wide into the stretch and passed tired horses. VITIUM, steadied in close quarters approaching the first turn, angled off the rail for the drive and steadied in traffic in mid stretch. ROCKINN ON BYE set a pressured pace along the rail and gave way in mid stretch. CAPTAIN'S AFFAIR (IRE), steadied in traffic leaving the backstretch, steadied in close quarters early, was outrun. FRAN'S BUCKAROO, checked in tight quarters early, raced wide both turns. An objection by the rider of SAINT PIERRE against the winner for alleged in the stretch drive was not allowed.
