CURALINA was bumped at the start and stumbled, stalked the leaders from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-sixteenths pole, vied with EASTERN ROSE through a vigorous drive and edged away late. EASTERN ROSE pressed the pace of BIRD SENSE from the outside, moved up to offer a bid nearing the three-eighths pole, vied with that rival into the stretch, was taken on by the winner and gave way grudgingly to that rival after a prolonged drive. BIRD SENSE bobbled at the start, recovered quickly to set a pressured pace from the inside and gave way in the drive. SALLY RIDE was off slow and bumped, rushed to contend, chased the leaders from the outside and failed to gain in the drive. ALPINE SKY was bumped at the break, settled off the leaders from between foes, moved outside through the turn and did not threaten. FLOWING lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn, angled out further in mid-stretch and was not a factor. WONDER BREW raced off the pacesetters early, moved outside through the turn and failed to rally. PRINCESS MOON bobbled at the break and was bumped, raced unhurried early and did not reach contention. LOTS OF CHOCOLATE pressed the pace from the inside for three furlongs and weakened.
