CURALINA effortlessly out-raced a pair of opponents proceeding along the homestretch to hitch up to CARRUMBA, travelled three to four wide on the clubhouse bend, began the run down the backstretch floated into a snugger fit in the four path by the leader, stayed latched on as the pair made their way to the half mile pole, followed the runner up's cue and picked up the pace when that foe did leaving that station, whittled away at the deficit, was confidently handled taking over control by a short length entering the stretch, responded positively when switched over to brisk hand encouragement scampering away to a long lead, continued to pour it on in the final furlong, crossing the wire, still hand ridden. CARRUMBA broke on top and maintained the advantage, gradually worked her way into the three path by the top of the backstretch, carved out the pace, with the winner accompanying her to the outside, picked up interest at the half mile pole, as did the prompter, saw the lead dwindle down steadily, was the first of the twosome to have its pilot commit to a drive, this occurring in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker, but all for naught, got left behind the winner down the stretch, but had no trouble salvaging second. SWEETGRASS along the inside, wound up saving the most ground, went on to best JOINT RETURN for show honors. JOINT RETURN off last, struck the right side of the starting gate, drafted behind the pacesetter during the initial stages, fell too far back to gain any benefit from that opponent's cover after departing the backstretch, swung four wide into upper stretch, had no offering and faded.
