TASK FORCE GLORY angled in to save ground near the tail of the field, commenced his bid midway through the second turn, worked out and around a tiring rival entering the stretch, dropped back to the inside, got through in rail skimming fashion and kicked clear. LANGDARMA was away alertly, shadowed the leader four wide, forged command nearing the furlong marker, continued on well but was unable to resist the winner. RIVER ECHO (GB) opened clear, set the pace along the inside, was collared midway through the second turn, weakened slightly during the drive and was all out to just hold the show. TOM'S D'ETAT was in tight into the first turn, moved up between horses, angled out entering the stretch but went evenly through the lane. TAKETOTHESTREETS was caught in tight and was shuffled back, rallied between horses, got through toward the inside into the lane and was making up ground. GOATS TOWN was unhurried into stride, made a late rally circled eight wide and improved position. DECORATED SOLDIER was close up four wide in hand, was fanned out further leaving the second turn, faltered entering the stretch and faded. CAPITAL LETTERS was allowed to settle five wide, moved up to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. GENERAL DOWNS was jostled between horses early and dropped back, was unhurried into stride, moved into contention on the second turn, but failed to sustain the drive. VAPORMAN fought restraint, settled under a hard hold, leveled into stride on the backstretch, but was through after a half. NAVAL GAZER was close up along the inside for six furlongs and dropped out.
