DECORATED SOLDIER unhurried through the first turn when four wide, ranged up while remaining in the four path second turn, put a head in front when straightened for home, long drive, fully extended to prove best. BIG RED ROCKET with the pace, dueled onto the backstretch inside, continued to vie closest to the rail the middle half, headed then regained the advantage into the far turn, hooked up with the winner entering the stretch, proved stubborn to the end while drifting out late and bumping with the winner just past the wire. UNEXPLAINED pinched back just after the start, raced well back early inside, continued to save some ground into the far turn, steered out four wide late in that bend, set down, finished well down the middle of the strip to be getting to the top two. Z ROYAL alternated up front outside the runner up for just over six furlongs then began to weaken from between the top two entering the stretch. MAJOR LEAGUE floated out just after the start, rated in the two path behind the leaders, saved some ground in the second turn, lacked a response in the drive. MADTAP rank in the first turn when forwardly placed, moved closer in the second turn in the three path, weakened in the drive. MALIBU MAX lacked speed while racing outside, continued back far turn, asked along four wide with a brisk hand ride into the lane, also came up empty. UNO MAS MODELO void of speed in trailing much of the way, never a threat. GIANT TRICK forwardly placed four wide first turn, allowed the two leaders go up the backstretch, five wide through the second turn, backed up in the drive. TISDALE three wide and off the pace, gave way in traffic second turn, trailed home.
