UNIFIED four then three wide in aim of the leader in hand and settled comfortably, advanced into the turn to latch on and apply pressure to the leader taking narrow command three furlongs from home, traded the front through to the five-sixteenths before taking over for good nearing the quarter pole, swung three then two wide for home straightened away, edged clear under a drive to the eighth pole, came under growing late threat and held safe to the finish as that rival latched on in the final jumps. GOVERNOR MALIBU crossed to the two path shortly after the start allowed to settle near the rear early on, remained saving ground unhurried until the five-sixteenths when put to coaxing, continued just off the inside into upper stretch, rallied angling out nearing the sixteenth marker offering up a good finish to threaten late, shied under a near sided stick and was corrected then latched on to the aforementioned foe in the final jumps. WILD ABOUT DEB three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, angled out six to seven wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick to secure the show honors in the late stages. ADVENTIST broke out at the start bumping DECORATED SOLDIER, raced three then two wide in mid pack, came under encouragement midway on the turn, angled five wide at the quarter pole, ran on through the drive but was outkicked. DECORATED SOLDIER bumped at the start by ADVENTIST who broke out a step at the start, chased four wide from mid pack, advanced midway on the turn put to urging into prominence stacked outside the top pair at that juncture, swung six wide at the quarter pole, weakened in the stretch. SINGLETON coaxed from the start, established the front and showed the way under light coaxing just off the inside, came under initial pressure approaching the midway point on the turn and was put to urging in response and headed briefly for command before trading the front to the five-sixteenths, got headed for good nearing the quarter pole, spun three wide at that station, then tired in the drive. LOST IRON detached early on at the rear saving ground, raced two to three wide through the turn coaxed along from the seven-sixteenths, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. SUPAH CZECH forwardly placed tracking the front in close aim, shifted to the two path five furlongs from home, began to retreat into the turn, came under a drive midway, backed away through the latter portion of the bend, swung four wide into upper stretch and faltered.
