PONYTAIL rated between foes early, eased out and looped the field rallying on the final turn, took the lead in early stretch and drew off. GIA ALEXA was three wide dueling, fell back a bit after a half, came on again to gain place while no match for winner. DELICATE LADY dueled for command two wide, was left with the rail and weakened late. WHOGOOSSEDTHEMOOSE, racing outside winner early, lacked a strong closing kick. BRAZILIAN SYMPHONY dueled for command along the rail and fell back. ELNATH saved ground while just off the pace, drifted out through the stretch and faded. T CROSS was steadied along on the backstretch, moved off the rail and was no factor. ABETS ABET broke slowly, raced just off the rail and never threatened.
