TAKREES was pushed out briefly by an incoming ANNA RAE as the field was sent off and running, settled into two path in midpack, picked up interest proceeding to get angled outward as the half was being completed, wound up four wide by the conclusion of the maneunver, launched an erratic rally down the stretch, moving outward and inward several paths at a time, usually after some stick work had been applied from the opposite side, arrived at the beginning of the final furlong full of momentum and the chief danger to the runner up, chopped away chunks of real estate, collared TRUE ROMANCE nearing the wire, even after shying out just before claiming the lead. TRUE ROMANCE one of three more or less unscathed at the start, got sent into the three path, was the widest of a trio arguing for the lead travelling down the backstretch, went at it one with BILEAPS AND BOUNDS past the half mile pole, but now having made it into the two path, put away the previously-named foe to emerge with a clear advantage at the quarter pole, was set down to a drive, left the eighth pole in possession of her largest advantage, was still holding most of it a sixteenth later, came out late after strong left sided stick work with the winner now looming boldly and got reeled in. DELICATE LADY bobbled prior to getting brushed and steadied by the pilot at the start, cut over to the rail and rode it for nearly a half, got put to a drive swinging to the outside entering the stretch, was four wide by the three-sixteenths marker, mustered up a mild response for the show award. APOLOGYNOTACCEPTED got guided over to the rail after the break, was the innmost of three contending for the advantage racing along the backstretch, got angled into the two path spinning into the stretch, lacked the needed response. ANNA RAE had the rider grab hold after breaking sharply to the outside, narrowing avoiding substantial contact with the starting gate, entered the stretch from the two path, was slightly wider exiting it, made no impact. LAXFIELD ROAD got checked while bumping with DELICATE LADY after being released from the gate, acted rankly while slow to settle into stride, was sent over to the inside and outrun thereafter. BILEAPS AND BOUNDS in the two path, vied from between rivals early, went on to duel with the second place finisher while placed on the inside route on the bend, surrendered as the half was being completed and retreated.
