CODACIOUS off a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, was in tight on the turn, came out in upper stretch, split foes in midstretch, gained the lead nearing the sixteenth marker and proved best under some urging. CINDYS SECRET chased outside then alongside a rival on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished well. DESERT STEEL dueled between horses to the stretch, gained the lead in the drive, could not match the top pair late but held third. SKY FOREVER settled outside then alongside a rival on the turn and into the stretch, came out in upper stretch and finished with interest. SUMMER WINE a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and bested the others. MISS LOUJEAN dueled between horses then steadled in tight a half mile out, stalked outside o the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. FAST MAGOO dueled four wide then three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened. HI FEVER steadled early, chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn and lacked the needed rally. TRIBAL EXPRESS chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. DESERT THIEF angled in and dueled inside, put a head in front on the turn, fought back into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong.
