

Footnotes

SO SWEETITIZ stalked inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch, bid four wide past midstretch under urging and gamely prevailed late. LATE SPRING saved ground chasing the pace, rallied along the inside in the drive and continued willingly to the wire. LONG HOT SUMMER settled off the rail then outside a rival, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and finished well. CINDYS SECRET had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail, fought back in the stretch and was edged for third. HOME JOURNEY dueled outside a rival, also fought back in the stretch and weakened some between foes late. DESERT STEEL stalked between horses, steadied in tight into the turn, continued between foes on the turn and in the stretch, was in tight off heels in deep stretch and outfinished. SHRINKING VIOLET stalked four wide between horses on the backstretch and three deep between foes on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SWIFT LADY in a good position stalking the pace five wide on the backstretch and four wide on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. SHE'S A BIG WINNER stalked between horses on the backstretch, dropped back between then off the rail on the turn and also weakened. A claim of foul by the rider of DESERT STEEL against the winner for alleged interference into the turn was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to substantiate the claim.
