LONG HOT SUMMER chased inside, came out into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead three wide in deep stretch and proved best. PAQUITA COQUETA (CHI) angled in and dueled outside a rival, stalked leaving the turn, bid again in the stretch, was between rivals in deep stretch and held second. XOXO had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away on the turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, drifted in a bit past the eighth pole, fought back inside the top pair and held third. LILY POD broke a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside in the stretch then steadied in tight past the eighth pole, came out and was edged for third between rivals. DESERT STEEL stalked three deep then outside a rival, came out three wide into the stretch and also was edged for a minor award three deep on the line. PRETTY N COOL chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SNOW CLOUD (IRE) stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, was between foes leaving the turn and three wide into the stretch and did not rally.
