FAST AND FOXY broke alertly and was hustled to the front, set the pace from the rail to the stretch then pushed clear to mid stretch and was much the best. LIGHT ONE was outsprinted to the turn, circled five wide to the stretch then battled DESERT STEEL through the lane for the place and got the nod. DESERT STEEL tracked the winner to the turn, was four wide to the stretch then got outrun to mid stretch and fought bravely for the place but missed. TOOMUCHISNOTENOUGH pressed the pace three wide to the stretch, got outrun to mid stretch then failed to offer a closing response. QUICK SONG had no speed, trailed three wide to the stretch then swung widest for the drive but never threatened. PLANE LUCKY got outsprinted early, was two wide on the turn and weakened in the drive.
