EMPRESS JINGU chased the front two to three wide in closest range, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, swung four to five wide into upper stretch, rallied between foes to issue a challenge a furlong from home, dug in splitting rivals and taking command a sixteenth out then rebuffed the threat outside to prevail at the finish. JUDY'S FUDGE chased five then four wide coming under encouragement five-sixteenths out, swung five wide into upper stretch, rallied the outermost of a trio battling out through the final eighth, fought on through to the wire but was ultimately rebuffed. YOUNG ANNA LEE cut the pace three then two wide through the turn coming under a drive nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide at that station, dug in under challenge from a pair through the final eighth and was headed a sixteenth out, kept on for the show honors well clear of the rest. UPTOWN LIZA four then three wide in pursuit under a ride from the five-sixteenths, angled five wide for home, weakened in the stretch. RUBICON chased in the overland route through the turn under a ride from the five-sixteenths, cornered four wide into upper stretch, made no impact. EIGHTH COMMANDMENT saved ground under prolonged coaxing from the seven-sixteenths, spun two to three wide into upper stretch and trailed throughout.
