AUSSIE PRAYER settled towards the rear of the field, was placed under a tight hold coming to the seven-sixteenths, continued under restraint while towards the inside on the turn, was let out after turning into the stretch, moved out a path or two then burst through an opening inside the three-sixteenths, rallied to the lead just inside the furlong marker, moved clear under a couple smacks of a right-handed whip and proved best under good handling. LULU'S BLUES settled on the outside, went three wide on the turn, was given her cue coming to the quarter-pole, rallied to make an outside bid in upper stretch, led into the final furlong, drifted out under a right-handed whip shortly thereafter, lost the advantage to the winner and was outfinished while able to get the place. SOMERSET SANDY broke out a bit then was hustled, was coaxed along near the middle of the field, raced in the two path on the turn, angled out behind horses in upper stretch, held a good striking position under the whip into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick and settled for the show. WANTAGH QUEEN settled towards the back on the outside, was roused at the three-eighths, went three wide on the turn, spun four wide into the stretch, came under the whip on the far outside and lacked the needed response. LAKEVIEW LADY showed early speed then dropped just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, hesitated while trying to move out after turning into the stretch, dropped back to the inside, had a clear rail opening, chased under a right-handed whip into the final furlong then weakened. GIVEN FIRE was hustled to the lead, set the pace, vied in the two path on the turn, was asked just inside the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch under a right-handed whip, lost the advantage outside the furlong marker and gave way. ESTHER THE QUEEN tracked the pace on the outside, went three wide on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, chased into upper stretch, drifted out some under a left-handed whip outside the furlong marker then tired. EMPRESS JINGU dropped back while urged along, went around the turn in the two path, came three wide into the stretch, drifted in near the three-sixteenths and failed to threaten while appearing uncomfortable over the surface.
