VENCEDOR sped to the lead at the start, set the pace throughout the backstretch, felt challenge of FACT CHECK in stretch, asked for more, responded kept clear. FACT CHECK raced behind the pacesetter in the backstretch, hustled up under right handed urging, moved up close off eventual winner, could not reach rival and kept on to hold place. AFRICAN CHIEF raced off the early pace, showed response racing two wide at the furlong marker, continued steady bid to the wire. AMP'D UP picked up the pace leaving the backstretch and moved up in range, came out in the turn and continued steady bid racing along outside of AFRICAN CHIEF in the late drive. LEGACY AZTECA raced off the pace in early stages, came out wide in the turn, showed some response but was not enough for impact. CRIME DOG tracked the top two leaders, made bid up inside at head of the lane, failed to move on, faded. BREAK IN THE STORM hesitated at the start, continued sluggish after the start and failed to make bid. STORMY MAN DAN hesitated at the start and trailed throughout.
