Footnotes

HELEN HILLARY chased between horses then a bit off the rail, continued between foes into and on the second turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and rallied along the fence under left handed urging to get up on the line. SCANDAL stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail, split horses on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch, bid outside then three deep in the drive, gained a slim advantage past midstretch and was edged late. GOSEECAL prompted the pace outside a rival, took the advantage leaving the second turn, fought back a bit off the fence in the stretch and was edged between foes late. ONZAWAY between horses then three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival then three wide into and on the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished. TAMMY'S WINDOW chased between rivals then a bit off the rail, continued between foes into and on the second turn and in the stretch then toward the inside in late and lacked the needed rally. FAST BID (IRE) broke slowly, pulled early then chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and three wide into the stretch, lugged inward in the drive and could not summon the necessary late kick. MY AUDUBON saved ground stalking the pace, came out some in deep stretch and lacked the needed rally. TIZ BAILEE sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail then inside leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, fought back leaving that turn and weakened in the stretch. HAVING FUN broke a bit slowly, angled in

outside a rival then inside into the first turn, saved ground off the pace, steadied off heels into the stretch, came out a bit and lacked the needed response. SHE'SASHOCKER stalked the pace outside a rival, went three deep into and on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. BEE SWEET was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, fell back four wide a quarter mile out, angled in some into the stretch and also weakened.
