Footnotes

FEATHERED off to a good beginning, had enough speed after the getaway to out-race most of the competition and work out a tuck into the pocket before arriving at the end of the homestretch, tracked the pacesetter, patiently handled until midway on the second bend, was switched over to light hand urging as six furlongs was being completed, cut the corner into the stretch, altered course to be outside the runner up after going a few additional strides, was asked for her best and willingly gave it, emerged at the end of the furlong grounds as the new leader, steadily pulled away from the second place finisher, kept busy to the end. CHOCOLATIER (FR) broke on top and maintained commamd, was rated along the hedge setting the splits, accompanied by SEEKING HER GLORY parked out in the two path, completed the run around the far turn, but with the eventual winner now lurking as the main danger, got turned loose for the drive, held out to the eighth pole before relinquishing the advantage, forged on ahead to be second best. FLAMINGO LANE forwardly turned three wide on both turns, held on well to secure the show, although proving no match for the top twosome. HOPE CROSS (IRE) in the two path early, travelled three wide on the far turn, fanned out a couple of more paths during the initial portion of the stretch, lacked the needed late response. RUNWAY GIANT had a ground-saving journey, began to pick up the pace when put to some hand urging after departing the backstretch only to have rider then tap on the brakes after coming up to the top one, likewise saving ground at the time, remained glued to the hedge proceeding down the lane and had no rally. RUN OF THE RIVER got checked a few strides after the start after being pinched back, was towards inside early, rating unkindly, indicated by pulling with

noticeable force on the bit, squeezed its way firmly into the two path leaving the first turn, was given some rein in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, quickened while getting angled out, finished the move being seven wide, made no headway in the final furlong. NOMINATIVE reserved in the two path, travelled three wide on the far turn, was under a drive making its way into the six path after spinning into the stretch, mustered up a mild response kick once straightened away to improve position. ROBILLARD off the inside, was between rivals on the opening bend, made no impact. MAGGIE NEARY (IRE) saved ground to the quarter pole and was never involved. SEEKING HER GLORY stalked the pace two wide and gave way.
