CARRADINE established the front and showed the way in hand along the inside then in the two path five furlongs from home, got coaxed along midway on the turn under pressure from a pair, spun just off the inside for home, got bumped three-sixteenths out as THE CARETAKER drifted in, dug in head to head with that rival trading leans on one another headed for command a furlong out, drifted out slightly inside the final sixteenth coming again and under new threat outside from FLEET IRISH, dug in gamely to get up in the final jumps the innermost of a trio hitting the wire together. FLEET IRISH bumped at the start by TEN TWENTY NINE, raced two then three wide through the first turn, settled three wide just off the pace, came under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home, angled five wide into upper stretch, rallied to issue a challenge through the final furlong latching on the top pair and being guided inwards to get a good look at his rivals a sixteenth from home, just missed at the finish. THE CARETAKER three wide through the opening bend, settled three wide in aim outside a pair, came under coaxing four wide three furlongs from home, spun five then four wide into upper stretch straightened away, drifted in and bumped with CARRADINE, dug in head to head taking narrow command a furlong out, traded leans and light bumps as that rival drifted out while knocking heads through to the finish, fought on between foes through the final sixteenth when joined by FLEET IRISH outside and was bested in the last strides to the finish. MANIFEST DESTINY forwardly placed two then three wide between foes attending the pace, came under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled three wide for home and was shaken of straightened away, then weakened in the stretch while along for the last major share. MR. BUFF four wide through the first turn, chased four wide coming under coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, angled four to five wide at the quarter pole and tired. TEN TWENTY NINE broke out at the start bumping FLEET IRISH, saved ground in pursuit from near the rear, came under coaxing at the seven-sixteenths, swung just off the inside for home and tired. THIRSTY DONNERSTAG two to three wide chasing just off the pace early on, angled out to the six path nine-sixteenths from home, tucked three wide into the far turn, swung four to five wide into upper stretch and tired. JO'S BOLD CAT chased just off the inside from near rear under a ride from the seven-sixteenths and made no impact.
