COMPASS STONE, prominent between foes from the outset, pressed the issue outside a rival racing into the bend, continued to force the issue to upper stretch while maintaining a narrow advantage and prevailed in a long drive. TARASENKO, urged to dispute the pace while angling inside, dueled for command into upper stretch in a protracted skirmish and grudgingly contested the issue to the wire. CATANOVA, caught four wide early tracking just off the first flight, continued with a steady bid into upper stretch was making mild progress late. GASLAMP broke slowly, shifted out early while racing into the last flight to the turn and made an effort to improve position while failing to seriously menace. CHICORY BLUE settled outside foes in the last flight early, angled to the inside racing into the turn and made an effort to improve position. JAIS MICHAEL was a brief factor three wide between foes tracking just off the first flight but retreated early. THISBABYSARULER angled to the inside early tracking the leaders as part of the second flight but steadily faded into the stretch. ROAD HILLS ducked inwards racing through the gap and dropped out early.
