GASLAMP broke through the gate prior to the start, was brought back around and reloaded, brushed with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging at the seven-sixteenths, went three then four wide on the far turn, swung seven wide into the stretch under the whip, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. WHISKEY BIZ was taken up while rank into the first turn, continued eager while a touch off the rail on the first turn, remained under heavy restraint, pulled hard behind horses at the half-mile pole, checked leaving the backstretch, was asked while in the two path on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, made a bid between horses at the three-sixteenths, bumped with rivals on both sides at the furlong marker, forged his way to the front into the final sixteenth but was caught in a brutal trip. PARADING GROOM bumped hard with a rival at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled well back on the outside, was urged along while three wide early on the far turn then moved to the five-path, was fanned nine wide into the stretch and finished with good energy to get the show. WILSPERFECTSUCCESS went four wide on the first turn,

stalked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch under the whip, bumped with rivals on both sides at the furlong marker, battled into the final sixteenth and missed while just able to get the last spot in the superfecta. LOVE TREE became fractious when GASLAMP broke through the gate, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, jostled with FUTURE EXPESS leaving the backstretch, went three to four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the five-sixteenths, floated six wide into the stretch, came in under a right-handed whip at the three-sixteenths, jostled with WILSPERFECTSUCCESS at the furlong marker and was outfinished. GAVAR bumped soundly with an opponent at the start, was hustled to the lead, set the pace while in the two path, lost the lead at the guarter-pole, fought on bravely in upper stretch, was bumped and turned sideways near the furlong marker, battled into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished. FUTURE EXPRESS brushed with a rival at the start, went two to three wide on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, jostled with LOVE TREE leaving the backstretch, came under urging while two to three wide on the far turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch and finished willingly. CHERNYAHOVSKIY was well placed on the inside, drafted behind the leaders on the far turn, moved out while put to a drive inside the three-sixteenths, chased into the final furlong, was blocked behind a wall of horses in the final sixteenth and lost any possible chance. SHARP EAGLE EYE raced near the rail on the first turn, settled well back in the field, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, turned into the stretch under the whip and failed to rally. JENJENSGRASSHOPPER broke about two lengths slow, went two to three wide on the turns, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor. CINCINNATUS went four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, came eight wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. Following the race, the rider of WILSPERFECTSUCCESS claimed foul against WHISKEY BIZ for alleged interference at the eighth-pole. After the stewards' review, there was no change made to the order of finish.
